The following amendment to the BY-LAWS has been proposed. It reduces the number of board seats from 15 to a minimum of 10. It was approved by the Board and presented at the Congregation Meeting on June 20, 2011. *It will be voted on at the next Congregation Meeting on December 19, 2011.* Please make every effort to be there.

### Article V: Officers and Trustees

The officers of the congregation shall consist of President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Recording Secretary, and at least six additional Trustees. Board members will be elected for three year terms. Any vacancies occurring during a term will be filled by the president with the approval of the Board. Three or four Board seats will come up for election every year in rotation.
