STUDENT RABBI'S REPORT

As I've been preparing for Yom Kippur and Sukkote services at Shaaray Tefila, one text keeps on popping into my head. The short passage comes from Yemima, a Morrocan-Israeli mystic and teacher. Yemima told her students that her teachings were not her own, but rather came from a deeper, Divine source. As such, she would sometimes teach behind a screen so that her students did not place too much deference on her as an individual.

Take a moment to imagine the voice of a strong old woman, calling out from behind a screen: "the power to repair is greater than the power to break." Yemima taught these words about our time in the Jewish calendar, but I am taking them as a rallying cry about this time in the history of our country and world. It can feel like our individual and societal mistakes are too great to fix. Yemima speaks to this concern with a simple and deep optimism. The work of repair might be harder and more dangerous than the act of breaking, but it is always possible.


