Shalom Congregation Shaaray Tefila,

As we turn the calendar to March, we usher in the Hebrew month of Adar II; a time according to our rabbis, when we increase our joy each day. In Adar, we turn our hearts to revelry and jubilation as we prepare our souls for the raucous celebration known as Purim. On Wednesday, March 16<sup>th</sup>, we will gather virtually on Zoom to celebrate Purim. Together as a community, we will read through the whole megillah in a mix of Hebrew and English. Please, feel free to volunteer and read a chapter in whatever style you'd prefer. Funny voices and adult beverages are encouraged and costumes are practically mandatory. After the reading, we'll open up the program for socializing and Purim schpiel skits. We invite you to create or film your own Purim family schpiel, talent show, or musical parody.

On Friday March 18<sup>th</sup>, I will be visiting the community in person where I will offer a d'var during the Friday night shared community services, and on Saturday, March 19<sup>th</sup>, I will lead the congregation in prayer. In this specific parsha, entitled Tzav, we learn about the various offerings that can be made to G-d, including the offering for sin, guilt, and thanksgiving. In fact, we derive the notion of a hanging or standing light in front of the ark in every Jewish synagogue meant to represent the menorah of the Temple in Jerusalem, as well as the continuously burning fire on the altar of burnt offerings, designed to symbolize G-d's eternal and unextinguishable existence.

It is with a heavy heart that I announce I will be transitioning out of my role as Congregational Outreach and Engagement Coordinator.

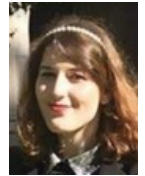

## ROSALIE ROTHSTEIN

*In the February, 2022 bulletin, Katie began a new project to feature one member each month. Bonnie suggested Rose Rothstein for the March issue due to her health issues. Since Rose was unable to write her own, which is ideally what is planned for these articles, Bonnie wrote this article for Rose, along with the help of family and friends.*

Rosalie Rothstein was born June 13, 1934 in Glens Falls, New York to Fanny (Berman) and Morris “Maishe” Goldstein. Rose’s siblings from the oldest are: Dora (Goldstein) Sheerer, Harry Goldstein, Rosalie (Goldstein) Rothstein, Libby (Goldstein) Levine and Jerry Goldstein.

Rose’s grandfather, Yankel Meyer Berman was one of the original members of Congregation Shaaray Tefila. Rose’s parents were married at Congregation Shaaray Tefila’s Jay Street Synagogue off Warren Street.

Rose and her two sons, Rick (January 6, 1953) and Bruce (June 7, 1954), of blessed memory, lived with her parents on Broad Street. Rick shared that his mother was amazing and worked very hard making sure that he and his brother had clothes for school and helped her parents for many years.

Years later, Rose met Jerry Rothstein. Rose had been a lifelong member of Congregation Shaaray Tefila and Jerry was a member since he moved from Brooklyn to Glens Falls in 1951. Rose and Jerry married March 26, 1961 in Pittsfield, Massachusetts. Their daughter Sheryl was born on Rose’s birthday, June 13<sup>th</sup> in 1963.

Jerry Rothstein was born on January 12, 1930 in Brooklyn. He was the son of Shirley and Harry Rothstein who were tragically killed in a car accident before Rose and Jerry married. Jerry had one brother, (of blessed memory) Sheldon, who was five years younger than Jerry. Jerry moved to Glens Falls to open and manage J & J Lingerie on Elm Street where he was manager until his retirement. Jerry received a Union Label Award of Merit in 1990.

Bruce worked with his dad Jerry at J & J for many years and managed the Granville operation then opened and managed a plant in Cambridge. Sadly Bruce passed away in 2003.

Jerry served on the Congregation’s Board of Directors for several decades. In 1983 and 1984, he was President of the Congregation. Rose served on the Board of Education when the combined Religious school was formed. Rose and Jerry were advisers for the USY (United Synagogue Youth). They were also on the committee which started BINGO and they both worked as volunteers at Bingo for many years to raise funds to help renovate the synagogue.

Rose and Jerry were members and staunch supporters of Hadassah. Rose is proud of being a life member. She is also a wonderful supporter of Sisterhood and is also a

proud member of the ladies who had a group Bat Mitzvah in 1998 – the B’Not Mitzvah Class.

As you can see with this history, Congregation Shaaray Tefila was a central part of Rose and Jerry’s lives.

In addition to all the years dedicated to Congregation Shaaray Tefila, Rose was also devoted to Weight Watchers of the Adirondacks. In 1966, Rose and her sister Libby opened the local Weight Watchers Franchise following training in New York City. On April 26, 1967, they opened the very first Weight Watchers of the Adirondacks meeting in Glens Falls. Their sister Dora became a Weight Watchers leader for many years. I (Bonnie) recall when my two brothers and I attended WW in 1968. My younger brother, Aaron and I lost 20 pounds and my older brother, Morty lost 250 pounds. Rose and Libby brought the founder, Jean Nidetch to Glens Falls and Jean honored several ‘major losers’ who walked across the Glens Falls High School stage in 1968. Rose was extremely proud of all she did to help many people through Weight Watchers of the Adirondacks.

Sheryl recalled the terrific trips to many areas with her mother when she worked for WW. “As a single young adult those are my absolute favorite memories – our times and travels together in Weight Watchers. I followed in mom’s footsteps traveling the six counties to do meetings. We also traveled throughout the country to franchisee association meetings, we laughed and had so much fun.”

Sheryl shared how much Rose and Jerry treasured spending quality time with their family and friends. Her parents loved boating, golfing, traveling, entertaining and visiting their grandchildren.

Libby and Rose worked hard with Weight Watchers. After about nine years, Libby moved and sold her part of the franchise to Rose. But the three sisters remained close and their first overseas adventure together was to Egypt and Turkey.

When Libby lived in San Francisco, Hawaii and Tahiti with her husband, Rose and Jerry would always travel to visit them. Libby enjoyed more years of travel with Rose after Jerry passed in 2013. They loved visiting family in Israel (new-found cousins) and visiting her own niece (Levine side) in Hong Kong several times. They also traveled to Australia, Russia, South America, Greece and enjoyed cruising. They were very close sisters and loved to travel even when Rose needed to use a wheelchair. The last trip just prior to COVID to the Caribbean with Dixie Land Bands playing all over the ship. Rose and Libby loved to be in Queensbury in the summer then return to FL following services for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur at Shaaray Tefila.

Rose’s brother Harry loves that, “Rose always put on a very special Passover (dinner) Seder every year for the family.” He also shared how the ladies talked about how much they enjoyed a Mediterranean cruise that the four



of them went on years ago... Rose Libby, Dora and sister-in-law, Betty.

Betty said, "Rose is one of the kindest, sweetest ladies she ever met. She is loving, caring and a good friend."

Sunny Buchman sent a special letter.

*This is a love letter and tribute to you, Rose:*

*You are a longtime friend who means so very much to me. I have never known a more hardworking, generous, family conscientious soul than you. I am deeply proud to have shared a special friendship with you over these many years. About the same age, we both grew up in Glens Falls and attended Sunday School at 68 Bay St. In those days you were Rosie Goldstein and I was Sunny Aronson. We both married and raised our children in Glens Falls. We enjoyed our friendship as couples and we shared our love for Judaism, Shaaray Tefila, United Jewish Appeal and Hadassah as well as miscellaneous other Jewish organizations.*

*You and Jerry opened your beautiful home over and over again to make it possible for the organizations to hold large meetings and fund drives in the warmth of your home environment.*

*You became a member of our community's Young Jewish Leadership. You became a Hadassah Life Member and were one of the first couples in Glens Falls to become Hadassah Keepers of the Gate.*

*You were so happy and proud to be able to donate the meaningful and beautiful Eternal Light that graces our synagogue sanctuary. But most of all I shall remember always how much it meant to you to be one of the eighteen B'not Mitzvah women who are the pride of Shaaray Tefila.*

*You are greatly loved by all of us, Rose.*

The whole Mishpacha (family) – siblings, children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews, cousins and friends love you so much Rose!
