Happy May/ Iyyar tov!

This month is jam packed filled with Jewish and Israeli holidays! On Wednesday, May 4<sup>th</sup>, we pause to honor and remember those who have died fighting for Israel's freedom, as well as those who perished in acts of terrorism, during Israel's Yom HaZikaron. The very next day, on May 5<sup>th</sup>, Jews from all over the world will celebrate Israel's Independence Day on Yom HaAtma'ut. Later in the month on Sunday, May 29<sup>th</sup>, Israel commemorates Yom Yerushalayim, the day in which Jerusalem was finally unified under Jewish control during the 1967 Six-Day War. These nationalistic holidays give us an opportunity to consider our relationship with the state of Israel as well as with worldwide Jewry. What is our connection to Israel? How does Zionism impact our Judaism? Do we feel an obligation, if any, to the international Jewish community? Over the last year, we have seen various images of Israel; a powerful I.D.F fighting back against Gaza militants, a compassionate care-giver in international humanitarian efforts ranging from the Surfside building collapse to hurricane relief, a cutting-edge medical giant in the pharmaceutical world, or as a harbor of safety to Ukrainian Jews during a time of war. Sometimes we fixate on one specific representation when we characterize our opinion of Israel; Masada, Yad Vashem, Kotel, the Conflict, marzipan, etc. When in reality, like all relationships, our attitudes and opinions are probably shaped by a wide spectrum of complicated, nuanced factors, events, memories, and experiences. So, as we add another candle to the birthday cake, what image are you thinking about on Israel's 74<sup>th</sup> Independence Day?

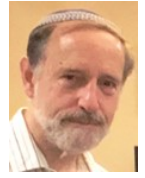

As I write this message, we are preparing for Yom Hashoa April 28 at 7PM, which will also be in-person at the synagogue and on Zoom. David Matzner will be our speaker, relating his family's experience with the Shoah and the aftermath. Thanks to Katie who is helping organize the event and to all those from the Shaaray Tefila and Temple Beth El who are bringing this event together. Covid vaccination is required for in-person attendance at this event.

As we are now well into our third year of pandemic, we continue to monitor the Covid situation daily to determine how and when to modify our approach to Jewish communal life. I recognize that there is a spectrum of thought and feeling about how open or restrictive we should be. We have been gradually loosening restrictions as the nature and intensity of the epidemic has changed. Among the changes that have determined the way the virus is impacting us is the change in the virus itself, which has become more contagious but somewhat less deadly. In addition, most of us are fully vaccinated and/or have had the disease, providing us with some level of immunity that is likely to prevent severe disease. We also are realizing that this virus is not going

away and we will need to learn to live with it. A huge consideration is the prevalence of the virus in our community, which at the time of this writing, is still relatively low. On the other hand, we don't want to take foolish chances with the health of our congregants. We are trying to steer a reasonable middle path that provides options for participation for those with all levels of risk tolerance and personal health considerations.

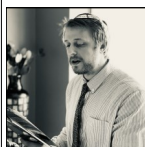

*In the February, 2022 bulletin, Katie began a new project to feature one member (hopefully!) each month. This month we are featuring Mike Pletman who is new to the congregation and is also a board member. Here is Mike's story in his own words.*

First of all, I am a native of Schenectady and taught 5th and 6th grades for 32+ years. I most enjoyed having great discussions with students based on novels we were reading, students writing their own novels and poetry books, coordinating optional student/adult at-home book clubs including one that brought a yearly visit, for 23 years, from a Holocaust survivor to share his story, and regular visits with a bus load of my students every month to spend time at an assisted living facility. I looked for ways to involve and help the community such as yearly readathons to benefit the Double H Ranch and shaving my head, along with many students, for many years to benefit pediatric cancer research with St. Baldricks Foundation. I am very honored that I retired in time to be with my wonderful parents for around two years to help in anyway as their needs increased. It is a mitzvah to have had that time. Now, I teach virtually via Outschool.com and, not only was it awesome during the pandemic but also now and I have taught learners in 43 states and 24 countries. I continue to teach on-line now and enjoy it very much. I have learners from Lake George to Bermuda to Vietnam, to California and more.

I moved full time to Glens Falls two years ago with the idea that it brought me very close to Lake George for boating, a favorite hobby of mine. I have a boat kept at Harris Bay. I also enjoy collectible cars, community volunteering, music, reading, cooking, and guitar playing. I used to perform with a Judaic Rock Band called Shir Chadash and actually used to come to the combined Sunday schools way back in time to sing with the students. One of the highlights of music for me was getting the opportunity to play music two years in a row with Pete Seeger. I used to perform as often as I could,

pre-covid, mostly folk, country, rock specializing in songs that really tell powerful stories. And, of course, I have an awesome dog, Derby, the Wonder Dog. I am an avid dog lover!

I spent over twenty summers working at two wonderful Jewish overnight camps, Pinemere Camp and Camp Ramah New England. My time at camp formed so much of who I am today and many of my best friends come from those days.

It has not been all easy moving to Glens Falls during the pandemic as I truly have met very few people in the town and even fewer in the Jewish community. I look forward to that very much so as to feel a part of the town. I am proud to serve on the congregation board.
