



## DOROTHY CHARY-MORRISSEY

*In the February, 2022 bulletin, Katie began a new project to feature one member (hopefully!) each month. This month we are featuring Dolly Morrissey. Here is Dolly's story as gathered in interviews between Bonnie Yanklowitz, Dolly and her family.*

Dorothy Chary-Morrissey, daughter of Anne (Thall) & Joseph Eddelton, was born on October 15, 1935 in Brooklyn, NY. Her mother immigrated from Russia on April 15, 1912. Anne traveled on the Carpathian which picked up Titanic Survivors. Joseph worked on the Manhattan Project in the 40's and assisted with the design of the NYC Electrical Grid system. Her parents retired in West Palm Beach, FL until her father was 101. He visited our shul with Dolly when he was in his 90s.



Dolly has a younger sister, Judith Nachami.

Andy recalled his mother sharing that the first movie she watched was the "Wizard of Oz". As a teenager, she enjoyed riding a horse and spinning under the horse as it was running. Bunny said that her mother was good at the trick riding, and in later years, played tennis, loved gardening and French cooking.

Dolly attended Brighton Beach Academy and attended Hebrew school several days a week at a nearby synagogue. She graduated high school at age 16 in 1951.

Dolly met Bunny's father, Charles Greenhaus at a dance in Merrick, NY and married in 1954. Bunny was born October 21, 1955. Sadly, her father passed away from Leukemia in January 1956.

Dolly attended Hofstra University for her BA, Columbia University for her Masters and received her second Masters in school administration.

Louis (Louie) Chary and Dolly met when they taught at Baldwin High School in Long Island, NY. They met in 1957 and were married on June 21, 1957. The family moved to Westchester County and Dolly taught French and Spanish at John Jay High School in Cross River, NY. Louis became the foreign language department chair at Fox Lane Senior High in Bedford, NY. Louis adopted Bunny. Bunny (Gene) now lives in Rogersville, TN and is a retired property manager. Dolly and Louis had two sons: Thomas (Tommy) who was autistic and passed at age 12 and Andrew, Andy (Lisa) who lives in Tupper Lake and is an architect. Andrew was born March 8, 1962.

Dolly always wanted to become a veterinarian. Women were not allowed at the time. She retired from teaching and was accepted to Cornell (after many applications to Vet schools). Andy and Bunny recalled that the only way she could go was to teach French while attending Cornell. That's when they moved to Ithaca (1988) and Dolly graduated from Cornell in 1992. Before Dolly graduated from Cornell, she completed a year internship at Plattsburgh Animal Hospital. Following her graduation, she worked for a few other vets then decided to open her own practice, Chester Veterinary Hospital at Bonnie Belle Farm in Chestertown, NY. (Years later, Dolly started a Veterinary Studies Program at SUNY Adirondack.)

By 1994, the family moved to Chestertown. They summer vacationed in Chestertown since 1973. Dr. Dorothy Chary opened the Chester Veterinarian Clinic in 1995 and soon after, sadly, Louis passed away.

Robert Morrissey needed a vet for his dog and Dolly and Bob started dating. Dolly and Bob married in 1998. Father Michael Abraham officiated the wedding. Bonnie recalls the wedding in Chestertown at Bonnie Belle Farm in the beautiful backyard! What a wonderful ceremony with family & friends!

Bob's children are: Karen, Lynn, Jodi and Robert (Bob), Jr.

Dolly's grandchildren are: Jana, Whitney, Leah, Emily, Adam, Michael, Amanda, Alexandra. Jana (Marshall) live in FL and helped Bunny (Gene) and Dolly immensely setting up the FL apartment following Dolly's move from Queensbury where Whitney and Emily packed the house.

Her great grandchildren are: Taylor, Jordan, Kayla, Devin, Ryan, Zephyr, Ava, Levi, Ronin and Harper.

She taught Sunday School for the Temple-Synagogue Religious School (TSRS). She taught on Wednesdays

when there was still Hebrew school. Also Dolly was on the TSRS Board.

Many friends were made at Congregation Shaaray Tefila and Temple Beth El. Some of her friends were Joan Charisse, Judy & Allan Korot, Ilana & Rabbi Elliott Marmon, Joan & Peter Weill, Gilda & Mike Siegel, Cher & Mark Hoffman, Marilyn Bazan & George Conable, Rabbi Boaz Marmon, Bonnie Yanklowitz, Francine Torra, Nancy Goldstein, Helene Rudnick, Robin & Mitchell Cohen, Rabbi Michael Samuel, Kaye Grossman, Carol (friend from community) and many more.

Ilana Marmon started a wonderful outreach program and Dolly was part of the large committee. When Ilana and Rabbi Marmon moved to Israel, Dolly continued the Rosh Hashanah Flower Project and the Purim (Mishloach Manot) Project. Joan Weill and committee continued the Purim Project for a few years. Dolly was very involved with projects/committees at the synagogue and in the community. She worked on the Vilna Cemetery Project and invited Dr. Michael Lozman for a program at the synagogue.

She taught Hebrew evening classes at the synagogue and at Eleanor Elliott's request, she also taught Yiddish. Dolly also taught review French at The Glen. Many residents of The Glen enjoyed the opera DVDs that Bob and Dolly presented.

Scott Schwartz, Dolly and committee organized picnics at Haviland Cove and Crandall Park for the synagogue, temple and community with help from the Jewish Federation of Northeastern New York and donations from participants.

Francine, Nancy, Cher, Bonnie and Dolly prepared Kiddushes for many years. At times Judy Korot, Marilyn and George, and Helene Rudnick assisted. Dolly and I were Sisterhood Co-Presidents for several years. At that time, Sisterhood members and friends were very involved with monthly meetings and programs. Dolly was Vice-President for Education when Shirley Kanofsky was Sisterhood's Chaplain.

Dr. Dolly Chary-Morrissey donated countless hours of Veterinary care to congregants, friends, Adirondack Save-a-Stray and the community.

Bob and Dolly loved Lion Country Safari in Loxahatchie, FL. They were Snowbirds and enjoyed Queensbury other times of the year.

Dolly and Bob enjoyed their travels to Vilna, Lithuania, St. Petersburg, Russia and Hawaii. They also enjoyed trips to Bob's naval reunions in CA and MD.

Following Bob's passing, Bonnie helped Dolly drive her 24' RV to and from FL for a few years until Dolly's Parkinson's prevented trips back and forth. Dolly and I loved the lions' roars at feeding times as the feeding cages were behind her home at Lion Country. Dolly's continued her devotion to NY Times Crossword Puzzles. She and I did those and others when I visited in FL.

Also following Bob's passing, Dolly finished a chapter and had Bob's book published-THE ADVENTURES of SPIKE the CAT. Dolly presented a program at the synagogue which was well attended. All supported Dolly's work on Bob's books where many were sold and signed.

Jordan's high school graduation in 2018 was Dolly's last time with her RV in Queensbury.

Dolly and I flew north for her family reunion at her son's in Tupper Lake about 2018 to which I was invited. Dolly stayed a few days at Judy & Allan Korot's then I drove, Emily's daughter, Ryan and great-grandmother Dolly to the reunion.

Dolly enjoys her chair yoga, Stretching Exercise class, Arts & Crafts and Torah Study class each week. The instructors are wonderful. Guests are allowed – I enjoy all classes when I visit.

Andy said that his mom has a permanent GPS in her brain. She was giving Andy the directions before his GPS did as we were going to visit Libby Levine, going to Dolly's CVS, to a favorite restaurant where she had not been in years. Despite Dolly's health, her medical knowledge, directions, reading and translating Spanish at the Norton Museum in West Palm, some memories and more are amazing.

Dolly attends B'nai Jacobs in Wellington and has enjoyed new shul friends. She also enjoys her friends Roz & Earl, Judy, Marie and others at her residence and her great caregivers.

Dolly told me how much she loved reading the bulletin and what a great job Katie does.
