Shalom Aleikhem! Greetings of peace and well-being to all whose eyes come across these words! We have made it to another month, again greeting the secular month of November soon after we welcome the Hebrew month of Heshvan. But, this time around, we find ourselves on the other side of a full season of Jewish holidays. Over the past several weeks, I had the blessing of sharing Rosh HaShanah, Yom Kippur, and Sukkot with many of you in Glens Falls. Over the course of these holidays, I spent time with members of our Jewish community ranging from 3-years-old to 99-years-old and I feel enriched for having had the opportunity to join together in prayer, study, and socializing.


As we step off from the high holy day season, we prepare to entire a lull in the Jewish calendar. Though there are days which are celebrated as holidays at the end of each of the secular months of late Fall and early Winter, our calendar takes a break from holidays until Hannukah. Rather than special celebrations, now is the season to settle into routines. After serious reflection and introspection into the ways we would like to improve our behavior in this new year, we now have the opportunity to integrate these goals into our regular daily routines. As the seasons continue to change, we have the chance to continue to change ourselves through making deliberate and intentional choices about how to structure our days.

In the daily, traditional liturgy for morning, afternoon, and evening, we repeat our gratitude for "the miracles which are with us in each day." Even when our rituals are not elaborate, our tradition encourages us to recognize the miraculous all around us and to articulate gratitude and appreciation! Let us take the opportunity this month to notice the wondrous around us and be thankful.

In that spirit, I will be teaching a two-part series of the fundamental Jewish structure for articulating gratitude: berakhot. Berakhos - usually translated as "blessings" - are possibly the most easily recognizable part of Jewish prayer. Yet, for thousands of years Jews have debated how to understand the radical act of making blessings. I hope many of you will join my on zoom twice this month for an exploration of the power of our blessings. I wish for you all nothing but blessings in this new month!
