Shalom to you and yours!

“Happy Holidays” is a greeting we can expect to hear from well-meaning neighbors and strangers as we begin this month of December and the

Hebrew month of Kislev. Yet, as Jews our main holiday season has already come and gone in Tishrei.

So, with what sort of attitude might we receive the well-wishes of our neighbors in this season?

To speak personally, I have often found myself frustrated with the way that a “season's greeting” can assume a fundamental similarity between Christmas and all other winter holidays. As Jews, I want us to appreciate the uniqueness of our Hannukah holiday and the messages we might glean from our particular seasonal celebration.

However, in recent years, as I have spent our winter Festival of Lights in more Northern climates, I have come to appreciate the simple power of every holiday that encourages us to bring more light into our lives during the darkest and coldest season of the year.

On Hannukah, which this year will overlap with the Christian festival that dominates our American society in December, we celebrate the rededication of our ancient temple. Like our ancient predecessors, we rededicate ourselves to Jewish culture and worship through lighting the Menorah. On a fundamental level, the light of the menorah represents our people's constant and continuous commitment to our G-d and our tradition.

This year and every year, when we light the menorah for 8 days straight during the darkest week of the year, we have the opportunity to embrace the power of each and every one of us to magnify light in the world. We can bring more light to our lives and the lives of all those around us! Paradoxically, it is during this season of increased natural darkness when we are guided by our tradition to realize our power to increase light.

So, I humbly suggest that whenever we receive a well-intended greeting this winter season and

whenever we find ourselves wishing for more well-wishes, we lean into the opportunity to magnify light. Let us share well-wishes with others and maintain the light in our eyes as we look upon the world!

Over the course of December, I will be joining the community for two Shabbatot along with religious school and a hannukah party! Thanks to the miraculous light channeled by our devices, I will also be leading Havdallah on zoom. I look forward to celebrating with you during this season!

Hodesh Tov! Here's to a good month!
