STUDENT RABBI MICAH FRIEDMAN



Hodesh Tov v'sameah! A good and joyful month to you! Our ancient rabbis taught "when we enter the month of Adar we increase in joy!"

However, the question is whether this statement is prescriptive or merely

descriptive. In other words, is it somehow our responsibility to increase in joy as we start this new month? Or, is it simply a general trend that people experience joy and gladness this time of year as Spring begins to approach?

I have been taught that in the ancient world feelings of joy and relief at this time of year were well justified. In an era when most people survived by subsistence farming, if you made it to this season, that meant you had survived the worst of Winter.

Yet, our experience is different. After a very meaningful weekend in Glens Falls in February, I am keenly aware of the fact that a number of the leaders of our congregation are acutely struggling with health challenges. What does it mean to increase in joy in this season, as our tradition teaches us to, when we find ourselves concerned for each other's well-being?

The imperative to increase in joy could seem cruel in such a moment. Yet, I feel that the mitzvot of Purim actually offers us concrete ways of showing kindness that can bring joy to all of us, even in hard times. There are 4 mitzvot of Purim. Of course, we read Megillat Esther, which we will be doing in partnership in Saratoga this year. The other three mitzvot, however, are focused on our relationships with others. We give gifts to the poor who are hungry and we also send gifts of food to our friends simply because it brings them joy to receive and brings us joy to give. Finally, it is a mitzvah on Purim to eat a celebratory meal, reflecting an understanding that making time to enjoy our food can bring us joy and healing.

When we consider these mitzvot, it seems that the true joy we are invited to experience in the month of Adar is not a joy of frivolity. Rather, the joy of this season emerges from our awareness that our

conditions of life are vulnerable, and therefore precious. With this awareness, we can realize that we have the power to help each other experience joy and gratitude even as face life's challenges head on.

The festivities should finish early enough for kids to get to bed at a reasonable time. It would be helpful if you would let me or Katie know if you are coming to the meal and/or service so we

can let the folks in Saratoga know how many to expect.

Mark your calendars for a communal second night Passover seder on Thursday April 6 at 6PM. Kosher for Passover chicken or vegetarian dinners will be available. We have not increased the cost for this in many years and again plan to keep the cost to \$25 for adults and \$10 for children and free for children aged 5 and under. Our costs are partially defrayed by a grant from Jewish Federation of Northeastern NY and are also subsidized by the congregation. Our Passover seder is one of the highlights of the year here at Shaaray Tefila so you won't want to miss it.

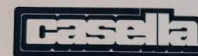
