Shalom! I hope this messages finds each of you well and enjoying the onset of Spring. Together, we celebrated the beginning of Spring with Passover a few weeks ago! Many of us enjoyed a delicious meal

together as we gathered for a community Seder. We ate, we sang, and we learned through exploring ancient Jewish wisdom and practices as well as through deepening our relationships with one another. Thanks to all who joined us for the Seder and for services over Passover.

We find ourselves now in the period of 7 weeks between Passover and Shavuot and in the Hebrew month of Iyyar. אייר This is a period of steadily paying attention to change. As the weather warms around us and plants begin to blossom and bloom, we also are called to attend to what might be shifting within ourselves. How might we grow new buds in this natural season of growth?

According to the Kabballah, אייר is an acronym for the end of a verse in Exodus 15:26 - אני יייר רופאך I am the One Who Is and Will be Your Healer. This comes to teach us that this month is an opportune time for healing and recovery. As I know that this is a time when many in our community and families are in need of physical and spiritual healing, I hope and pray that this season will offer us the opportunity for ongoing healing. As we prepare for Shavuot, the festival of receiving Torah, we also have a sacred opportunity to accept responsibility for supporting each other in our efforts to heal and grow.

The month of May will offer me the chance to make two more visits to Glens Falls! I look forward to leading a family Kabbalat Shabbat service on the first Shabbat of the month and hope to see many of you there! Of course, we will gather on Shabbat Morning for spirited tefillah, Torah, followed by food. I will return two weeks later in the middle of May, the week before the festival of the giving of our Torah.

I will lead learning for Shavuot over Zoom which I hope will both entertain and cultivate reflectiveness for all who participate.

BONNIE YANKLOWITZ

Since my birthday is in May (5/3) and I am grateful to be alive after 75, I decided to share my history as others did months ago. (Hope others will share soon.)

Congregation Shaaray Tefila has been very special to me although I was not involved during the late 60's-'72 with college, some teaching and grad school nor another two decades until 1995. In the mid-to-late 90's, my cousin Sunny Buchman, Rabbi Elliott Marmon, friends Harrie Bobbin, Dolly Chary, the Kudans, the Sterns, (working bingo with wonderful people) and the Rothsteins [from Weight Watchers-'68 helped my brother Mort lose 250# with our brother Aaron's support!] 'brought' me back to the shul.



My earliest memories were Sunday School with wonderful teachers and Rabbi Shuhalter. My most favorite memory is being a flower girl in my sister Ruthie's wedding on February 26, 1955 on the bimah upstairs. Our youngest

brother, Aaron was the ring bearer, her husband Joe's nephew was junior usher and my sister's high school friend, Eileen Cohen (Ornit's mother) was her maid of honor. (My brother Alvin had left for the service already.)

Other special memories were being part of USY (United Synagogue Youth) especially the time there was a special Convention including youth from many areas in NYS, VT and MA. Synagogue services and the Queensbury Hotel were our home for the weekend and my roommate was Adele Ryen. Adele's mother was Mary (Berkowitz) Ryen, sister to Rose (Berkowitz) Roth. Also Delta Psi Sorority of which I was President was very important to me. I graduated from Glens Falls High in 1965 with wonderful classmates! An actively strong USY and Delta Psi were special while attending Adirondack Community College (ACC) which was in Hudson Falls with an outstanding faculty led by President Eisenhardt. My World Literature professor was Mrs. Shirley (Cindy) Weiner, Larry Greenberg's aunt. The summer of 1967 when I transferred to State University of New York (SUNY) College at Buffalo, Rhoda Alkes became President of Delta Psi. My special Cousin Bella (Yanklowitz) Suckman was the Advisor.

Back to the past...

My great-grandparents, Yankelovitch came to America from Ivya/Vilna, Russia now Lithuania in the early 1900's and lived on Broad St. in Glens Falls. One son went to Argentina and kept that name, two sons were Yanklowitz, others changed last name to Persk, Goodman, and Yanks. Samuel and Hattie Yanks' son is Byron Janis, world-renowned concert pianist. His name changed from Byron Yanks when studying with Vladimir Horowitz who made the suggestion I heard.



Ethel Indgin, my mother was from Amsterdam, NY with 3 sisters and 2 brothers. She always talked about going to school with classmates of many cultures and learning their languages. My Bubby (grandmother) was a midwife to Kirk Douglas' mother. My aunt Libby I. Levenson was Kirk's

Sunday School teacher and my cousin Shirley

Suckman Simon is married to Kirk's nephew. Small world!



Louis, my father was from Granville with 3 brothers and 2 sisters. His father was a cattle dealer and passed away when I was 20 days old. My grandmother was a Rudnick and her nephew married Helene Brown. My father's sister Clara married William (Bill) Aronson. (One of

their daughter's, my cousin, Sunny and my mother's niece Barbara Jean Levenson Weiskopf were influences on me to become a teacher.)

My father was married and lived in Vermont until tragically (the nurse could not get the drunk Dr. to arrive at the hospital) his wife died following childbirth. My biological half-brother lived. I am still in touch with his family and his mother's family in Brooklyn and Staten Island-wonderful people who call me Cousin Bonnie May.

In 1934, my parents were married and lived in Johnstown then Gloversville where my sister, Ruth, brothers Alvin (Al) and Boris Benjamin (Ben) were born (Nathan Littauer Hospital). They moved to Utica and Irving Morton (Morty) was born in 1943. They moved to Glens Falls in 1945, lived on Broad St. until a move to Sarella St. off Bay. Dr. Milton Greenberg delivered me at Glens Falls Hospital in 1947 as well as my youngest brother, Barney Aaron David 2 years later.


