Side dishes, chips, dips, drinks, fruit and pareve desserts were brought by the participants.

Our special guest was Rob Kovach, President & CEO of the Jewish Federation of Northeastern New York, who brought friends and family members along with him from Albany to Glens Falls to enjoy the day and the beauty of the park and Glens Falls with all of us. The day was also an opportunity to learn about the history of both the Synagogue and the Temple.

Claire Kantrowitz and her daughter Karri Winans shared stories about Al Zweibelson, who was Claire's father and Karri's grandfather. Al was raised in NYC and was briefly in the Merchant Marines. Al was an artist, craftsman, sculptor, and cabinetmaker. He designed and created beautiful jewelry and furniture, and worked as a store window painter in New York City, where he stenciled words in reverse. Al's wife suffered from a heart condition and fresh air was prescribed, so the family moved up to Glens Falls, where Al applied his talents to helping both the Synagogue and Temple. He stenciled the names and dates of Synagogue members on the stained glass windows in the sanctuary. He carved the gavels for the Sisterhood and Hadassah meetings and built both yarmulke cabinets. Al also designed and created the stunning Tree of Life sculpture for the Temple, which is admired by all who see it.

A warm thank you to everyone who attended and brought delicious food, drinks, supplies and good conversation. May we all enjoy many more shared occasions together.
