KISLEV-TEVET



STUDENT RABBI NAFTALI HIRSCH

In just a week's time, we will enter together into the holiday of Hanukah. In the Talmud

(mShabbat 21b), asks "? מאי הַנוּכָה" What's Hanukah?", it being one of the 'newer' holidays instituted by our sages. In answer, they share the story of finding that single untampered-with vessel of oil – one day's worth. The problem, as we learn in Chidushei Agadot, is that it would take another 8 days to bring new pure oil to Jerusalem. Yet a miracle occurred, and it lasted 8 days, and the following year our sages declared that this time would be an ongoing festival for the Jewish people with the singing of Hallel and prayers of gratitude. The Book of Maccabees, meanwhile, tells the history of the war that preceded this moment and allowed for the rededication of the Temple, and so this holiday also marks the end of this violence in the Land. May we too see an end to violence in the Land as we kindle the Hanukah lights this year.

Traditionally one would place the

doorway of one's home in order to

Hanukah menora in the outer

publicize the light of the miracle, and in Jerusalem today you can see many stone gates or walls with little shelves built into them just for this which remains an ongoing custom amongst Sephardi and Mizrahi Jews. Ashkenazi Jews, since at least R Moshe Isreles' (Re'MA, 16th Cent.) time, have lit their menorot inside. In either case, there is a tradition to light the menora to the left of the doorway, since the Mezuza is fixed on the right hand side of the doorway. The *geonim* wrote that this is so that anyone who enters one's home on Hanukah will be surrounded by the warm embrace of mitzvot – of these ritual touchpoints for connection to the Divine. Whether you have the tradition to light your menora near the doorway or by a window, I hope that you will feel invited into deeper relationship with all that is around you. May each candle bring more light into our lives and inspire

us to bring of ourselves into this world. הג אור שמח
