# RABBI INTERN DAVID MALAMUD

The new year is upon us! Perhaps even sooner than you might think.

A midrash from *Pesikta d'Rav Kahana 23:1* states:

תני ר' אליע' בעשרים וחמשה באלול נברא העולם "Rabbi Eliezer taught: the world was created on the twenty-fifth of Elul?!"

Why would Rabbi Eliezer teach this?

You may be shocked to learn this, I certainly was. The Torah doesn't actually say that the first day of the seventh month is a new year at all, let alone the day the world was created! Only starting in the *Mishnah*, which is redacted in 220 CE, do we even get the idea that the first day of the seventh month is Rosh Hashanah, the new year for counting years. The *Mishnah* is far more concerned with painting Rosh Hashanah as judgment day for humans, something which our liturgy and most Jews associate more with Yom Kippur. It almost makes sense that the Torah doesn't call the first day of the seventh month a new year, since it is the seventh month after all.

But what about our Rosh Hashanah? Should we not celebrate this holiday as a holiday of creation? We sing the joyful piyyut, היום הרת עולם. Today the World was Born, and we tell our children it is the birthday of the world. But if it were the creation of the world, shouldn't read Bereishit 1, the story of the creation of the world? Instead, we read about the birth of Isaac and the sacrifice of Isaac. Why? The Tosefta Megillah presents a simple, but in my opinion, unsatisfactory answer: G-d visited Sarah and blessed her on Rosh Hashanah so that she could give birth. Certainly, other biblical events happened on Rosh Hashanah, so why do we highlight this one?

The opening midrash from *Pesikta d'Rav Kahana* continues:

בראש השנה נברא אדם הראשון

"On Rosh Hashanah, the first Adam was created."

The midrash further breaks down that sixth day of creation, hour by hour, until Adam and Even are pardoned, the implication being that just as Adam and Eve were pardoned on Rosh Hashanah, so too we will be pardoned. I think that this is why we read the last two chapters of *Parashat Vayeira*, the birth of Isaac and the sacrifice of Isaac. Both

stories reflect G-d's judgment and mercy. G-d has mercy on Sarah and lets her conceive and G-d has mercy on Abraham and Isaac and spares Isaac. Nachmanides, the Ramban, calls Rosh Hashanah "Yom Hadin B'rachamim," (Vayikra 23:24), the Day of Judgment with Mercy.

It is futile to avoid judging people in our own lives. I certainly am guilty of this sin. During these days of awe and for this following year, I invite us all (myself very much included) to emulate G-d in these moments. Inevitably, we will judge other, but I hope that we can temper that judgment with mercy.

Shanah tova u'metuka!

# YOM KIPPUR APPEAL

We are currently in a time of reflection on our past lives, as well as hopes and prayers for the coming year. This year, I would ask you to reflect specifically on our congregation. What has it meant for you in the past, at the present time, and

what potential does it hold for the future. Reflect on the loss you would feel if it was not here to be a center of Jewish life in the Greater Glens Falls region, providing an opportunity for personal and communal Jewish growth.


Every year our main fund raiser is the Yom Kippur Appeal. In the past, we have largely just asked for your generosity and hoped for the best. We have eliminated direct solicitation during Yom Kippur services. However, our income from this source has come up short in recent years.

This year we are setting a specific goal of \$26,000 for the Yom Kippur appeal, which is an increase from what was donated last year. Our intention is to avoid having to withdraw principle from our endowment, as well as to avoid raising dues, which have been stable for many years, and which remain well below what is charged by comparable synagogues. By increasing your voluntary financial commitment to the congregation, you will insure our fiscal health, pay for vital spiritual and communal needs, and also do your part to insure that we avoid creating financial barriers to full participation in our Jewish community.

Please consider increasing your Yom Kippur Appeal pledge this year by whatever amount you can. If you have already sent your donation, please consider a supplemental donation. This is a chance to show your appreciation for all that Shaaray Tefila has meant to you and to express your hope for further enriching Jewish communal


