Hodesh Toy!

Spring in Boston has officially sprung! During our extended visit to Glens Falls, it seemed to have arrived in Glens Falls as well. My family and I so enjoyed seeing old and new faces at services and our community seder. Thank you all for being so kind and welcoming to us, and to our boys in particular. I'm looking forward to visiting again in mid-May for my penultimate visit with this beautiful community.

There are many holidays, Jewish and secular, in our month of May, but I want to highlight a little, often forgotten holiday. Pesach Sheni is a holiday that appears in Tanakh, in Vayikra 9:10-11.

Speak to the Israelite people, saying: When any party—whether you or your posterity—who is defiled by a corpse or is on a long journey would offer a passover sacrifice to יהוה, they shall offer it in the second month, on the fourteenth day of the month, at twilight.

This is a make-up holiday, a month after Passover, a vestige of Temple Judaism. If you missed Passover, there's another chance to do the rituals. While we don't offer lambs anymore to Hashem, many folks in the more observant world will eat matzah to mark the day as special.

While I have my (many) differences with the Chabad Lubavitch movement, I find their interpretation of this holiday as beautiful. Their rebbes have taught that Pesach Sheni teaches us that it is never too late to make things right. The Rebbe taught that Passover symbolizes the birth of the Jewish nation, as we are liberated as a people from Egypt, so Pesach Sheni presents an opportunity to do teshuva, to repent. This is a time to address our own deficiencies, even fundamental ones.

What do I make of this? I think that too often we limit teshuva to specific seasons, whether it's Yom Kippur or the start of a secular year. We often make resolutions to act better at these moments, but I know I often struggle to maintain them.

I find this redemptive. I personally struggle with counting the Omer, another Temple ritual that we undertake by counting ritually, from the second day of Passover through the forty nine days leading up to Shavuot. Inevitably, even with the Chabad app, or cute reminders, I forget. Once you forget to count a single day in the Omer, you are no longer able to count with a brachah. Personally, I am guilty of saying, oh well, no brachah, no point. But that is exactly the wrong take-away!

Judaism is a religion of second chances, of teshuva, of changing and returning to the best version of ourselves that we can be. Nothing symbolizes this more clearly to me than Pesach Sheni. I challenge you all to embody this holiday of second chances. Maybe, like me, you are struggling to get back to the gym. Now is not the time to give up, give it another go. Perhaps, you are struggling with coming to shul, or counting the omer, or any number of Jewish rituals. Give yourself some grace, some empathy, and give it another go. I know that I feel reinspired to count the Omer, brachah, or not.




