### RABBINIC INTERN DAVID MAGAZINE MALAMUD

Hag Sameach!

I hope you all are enjoying a raucous Shavuot in Glens Falls. I am bittersweetly looking forward to my final visit on June 18-20<sup>th</sup>. It feels like I have finally gotten to know so many of you and now it is time for goodbye. For the upcoming year, I have accepted two internships, one in Medford, MA and one in Peabody, MA, both of which are much closer. I would have loved to spend another year with you all deepening our relationship, but as my children get older (two in July!), I am realizing the importance of savoring every moment with them.

Shavuot is, זמן מתן תורתנו, a time celebrating the receiving of the Torah in one transformative moment. It is easy to get swept up in grand moments of change and upheaval, but I want to talk a different kind of revelation.

Martin Buber, a late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> century German Jew, distinctly conceives of two kinds of revelation, the theophany (display of God, i.e. revelation) at Sinai and the theophany of exile. What is the theophany of exile? I am so glad you asked. In the 1913 preface to his book, *On Judaism*, Buber writes: "in that theophany, revelation does not flash from the cloud, but from the lowly things themselves; it whispers to us in the course of every ordinary day, and it is alive quite near us, quite close; the *shekhina* dwells about us, sharing our exile and our wait, and our suffering heals and is hallowed through the immanence of the Word" (6).

I first encountered this text at BU, where I was a PhD student in Religion before rabbinical school. I dug up this quote from an old exam I submitted comparing and contrasting different Jewish philosophers' interpretation of revelation, but I don't think I actually understood it. I was just answering an exam. But now I think I have an idea of this. In our past year together, I have witnessed the theophany of exile countless times, when we sing during psukei dezimra, when we have lively Torah discussions, and when we laugh during Kiddush. I think it is easy to take these moments for granted. But these moments, these bits of pottery, have made up a brilliant mosaic, this internship. I have learned so much from all of you and I will miss you dearly.

I want to challenge you all, in our final month together, to make the most out of it. Not just my visit, though I look forward to schmoozing with all of you. No, I challenge you all to be more mindful. If you pay attention, you might just see the shekhina waiting for you. You don't need to wait for Shavuot or even a Shabbat. There are moments of divinity all around us waiting to be seen.

Shavuot services will be held on Tuesday, June 3 at 9:30 AM. Yizkor will be recited on Tuesday morning. Please join us to celebrate the gift of the Torah and share in a traditional dairy kiddush of blintzes, cheeses, bagels and lox, salads, cheesecake and ice cream. We eat dairy because the Torah is compared to milk and honey, emphasizing its sweetness and nourishing nature.

Rabbinic Intern David Malamud will be conducting Shabbat services on Friday, June 20th at 6:30 PM and Saturday, June 21st at 9:30 AM. Please join us for services to show our support for him and our congregation. Also on Saturday, June 21st, at 7:00 PM, members of Congregation Shaaray Tefila and Temple Beth El will meet at the Crandall Park Monument to go on a short, easy hike and then have a Havdalah service. This is a fun opportunity to combine the physical with the spiritual!


