This newsletter is being published in the midst of the high holiday season between Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Although we usually think of Rosh Hashanah as a celebratory holiday and Yom Kippur as a solemn fast, there is a stream of thought within the Talmud that the reverse is true. We are supposed to tremble on Rosh Hashanah as we are being judged for our deeds and feel relief on Yom Kippur when our sins are purged. In support of the solemn

nature of Rosh Hashanah, consider that we don't wish each other "Happy New Year" as we do for the secular new year, or even "Chag Sameach – happy holiday" but rather "Shanna Tova! – a good year."

Nevertheless, centuries of Jewish custom have ensconced Rosh Hashanah as a celebratory holiday and we really don't celebrate Yom Kippur - at least not until the break-fast. This is one of the many instances where Jewish practice has been settled from the bottom up rather than from the top down. I hope you had an opportunity to celebrate Rosh Hashanah during enjoyable and meaningful services at Shaaray Tefila and elsewhere and to share apples and honey with us after services.

In this time of struggle and divisiveness in America, Israel and the rest of the world, let us empower Yom Kippur to not only purge us of our collective sins, but to mark a new beginning for our world, starting from the bottom up. I look forward to seeing you at services and at the break-fast.

We will have day 1 morning Sukkoth services on October 7 and Shemini Atzerit morning services with Yizkor on October 14, Simchat Torah services that evening and Simchat Torah morning services October 15. I hope to see you all at our services and in the sukkah for Kiddush.

Thank you to all whose help has made our services, Kiddushes and celebrations possible during this hectic but worthwhile Jewish holiday season.



Shalom and Happy New Year! When this issue of the bulletin goes to publication, Hebrew School will have

been back in session for almost a month. We are so excited to welcome each student back and our teen aides as well. As always, the beginning of the year focuses on reconnecting and Hebrew refresh. We move quickly to High Holiday celebrations with apple dipping and a round challah tasting as well as our Rosh Hashanah family service. We then celebrate history and harvest with Sukkah building with the community and our famous Pizza in the Hut.

November brings us a time of thanks and hope. In the United States and in Judaism we say thank you with the word "*Todah*." VERY FLUFFY HONEY CAKE

By Nitra Ladies Auxiliary on Kosher.com

Ingredients:

14 eggs, separated

2 cups sugar, divided

1 pound (1 and 1/3 cups) Gefen honey

1/2 cup oil

1 tablespoon liquor

1 tablespoon vanilla sugar

1 teaspoon cinnamon or grated rind of 1 orange

4 cups flour

1 teaspoon Gefen baking soda

1 teaspoon Haddar baking powder

Directions:

Beat egg whites until stiff. Gradually add one cup sugar until stiff peaks form.

Beak yolks with remaining sugars until lemon colored. Add honey, oil, liquor and cinnamon.

Sift flour, baking powder and baking soda.

Gently combine egg whites, yolks and flour until well blended and smooth.

Pour into a lined 10- x 16-inch pan or two tube pans. Bake at 400 degrees Fahrenheit for 15 minutes. Reduce temperature to 325 degrees Fahrenheit and bake for an additional hour.


